# 2022 HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION DUES

On February 2, 2022, the ARHA Board of Directors voted to set the annual association dues at \$135.00 for 2022 with an early payment incentive reducing dues to \$125.00 if payment is postmarked on or before June 1, 2022. The annual dues invoice will be mailed to homeowners in April. Annual dues are used to pay for such expenses as neighborhood maintenance, website fees, insurance, legal expenses, social events, and miscellaneous expenses to make sure our neighborhood remains a great place to live. The Autumn Ridge HOA remains in great financial position, and we have not had to raise dues in several years. We are looking at opportunities we will have in the upcoming years to continue to make the neighborhood the best possible place to live in Omaha.

# Paying Dues Online!

The Board has partnered with an organization called Cheddarup to create a payment portal on the website so that you may pay your annual dues by credit card or bank draft. This portal will be completely secure and allow for easy payment. There will be a convenience fee for usage of the portal, and that will go directly to Cheddarup. The link is not quite ready, but will be by the time your official dues notice is mailed in April.

# **COVENANTS**

It's a good time for a friendly reminder about our covenants. Please remember that storage of trash receptacles on driveways, except on your assigned trash collection day, is not permitted per Omaha Municipal Code and per Autumn Ridge Covenants Article I.9. We ask that you please move your trash can(s) to a location where they cannot be seen from the street. Additionally, our covenants do not permit boats, trailers, campers, etc. to be stored in driveways and there are provisions covering swimming pools, signs, car repairs, junk, rubbish, roofing materials, etc. You can find further information at our website www.myautumnridge.com.

If the board observes instances where our covenants are not being followed, we will make contact with the homeowner by mail, citing the covenant section, and request that action be taken to conform. Please understand, that one of our primary directives is to enforce the covenants to keep the neighborhood looking and feeling the way we want it to be. We appreciate your understanding of the role the board plays in this and thank you for working with us.

#### TRASH COLLECTION

Trash & Recycling collection is much improved from when the new trucks started in 2020. Some things to remember. The trucks will only pickup what is inside the bins, and recycling is every other week. Items you can put in the recycling bins are Plastic Bottles, Aluminum Cans, Paper & Cardboard. 
